

ARRIVAL AND ENTRY

- Please don't attend if showing any of the symptoms i.e. continuous cough/fever or high temperature/loss of, or change in sense of smell or taste.
- Please arrive in good time to avoid crowding at the door.
- If there is a queue remember to physically distance 2m.
- Wear a face covering and do not shake hands or hug.
- Register your name with a member of the welcome team.
- Use the hand sanitisers provided when entering the building.

SEATING

- A steward will show you to your seat and will take into account physical distancing.
- Members of the same family and extended households may sit together.

COMMUNION

- Communion will be taken using individually pre sealed bread and wine packs which will be provided (on arrival).

TOILETS

- Please try to limit the use of toilet facilities.
- If you visit, wash your hands thoroughly and dry using the paper towels provided, disposing in the bin.
- Use the sanitising cloths to wipe the toilet handle and seat, wash basin, taps and door handle, disposing in the bin.

EXIT

- Please leave the building immediately after the service maintaining physical distancing, one row at a time from the front. Leave by the fire/disabled door following the exit arrows, using the hand sanitiser at the door.
